1.Product Data

This product acquires, generates, or collects data related to its performance, usage, and surrounding environment during use. This data is used to record shooting activities, shooting modes, and parameters (such as stabilization, image quality, and frame rate settings); to reflect the device's power level and operating status to ensure normal operation and facilitate troubleshooting; and to record motion tracks, the location, time, and surrounding environmental conditions at the time of shooting, helping to reconstruct the shooting scene and optimize the product experience.
